COCKTAILS IN THE TROHPIQS

Kicking off the year strong, **Cocktails In The TROHPIQs** will be held in February and never disappoints as one of our most popular social events of the year. For many new members, this is their first exposure of what TROHPIQ has to offer. For our returning members, it serves as a highly anticipated start to another year. In 2024, this event attracted **63 attendees** and was held at The Sound Garden. Numerous membership sign-ups followed the event and it provided a great platform to introduce and promote TROHPIQ's upcoming events, opportunities and sponsors! We hope you join us again this year as first impressions are the most lasting!

BOWTIES & BEAUTIES CHARITY GALA

The Bowties & Beauties Charity Gala is the highlight of TROHPIQ's social calendar. Held annually to raise funds for BUSHkids, students hailing from **all** health degrees support the cause and enjoy dressing up, food and drinks, and live music. It is our privilege to host representatives from BUSHkids to speak at our event and spread awareness of the phenomenal work they do for the health of rural families.

All proceeds from the gala are donated directly to BUSHkids – in 2023, this was a record-breaking **\$4750** from over **100 attendees**. Over half of the money raised came from the extremely popular **raffle tickets** which were generously supplied by our sponsors. We are once again seeking the generous support of our partners to ensure an even more successful evening in 2025. If there is one event to look for, this is the one!



CHERBOURG TRIP

TROHPIQ's annual **trip to Cherbourg** aims to introduce students from various health disciplines to First Nations and rural health. Cherbourg, also previously known as Barambah, was originally founded as an Aboriginal settlement and is now the third largest Aboriginal community in Queensland. This trip includes a tour of the historical ration shed museum, running of **health promotion stalls** at the Cherbourg sports grounds, a tour of Cherbourg Hospital, and a visit to nearby rural towns.

This event remains our leading cultural and rural experience that leaves a lasting impact on attendees, who are always extremely grateful for sponsors' assistance in this journey.

RURAL GENERALIST BREAKFAST

This breakfast represents our major informative social event that attracts both non-members and members alike. It is held concurrently across **Brisbane**, **Hervey Bay**, **Bundaberg and Rockhampton** sites. Students hear from experienced doctors and many of TROHPIQ's sponsors about working in rural locations and the Queensland Rural Generalist Pathway. Thanks to the generosity of our sponsors, we were also able to provide breakfast at each site, which is always a hit with students!

TREES OBSERVERSHIP PROGRAM

The **TROHPIQ Rural Elective Experience Scholarship** (TREES) is a collaboration with the UQ Rural Clinical School aiming to provide first year medical students the opportunity to experience regional and rural Queensland. Students are selected to complete a 2-week placement in a rural location and receive a bursary. The student bursaries are solely funded by TROHPIQ to assist with travel and accommodation costs associated with the placement.

In 2024, we were incredibly proud to support **35 students** through our **TREES Observership Program**, from a pool of 46 applicants!

As TROHPIQ's flagship scholarship program, we have steadily increased the number of our scholarships each year. Your support will enable more students to experience the world of rural medicine, often for the first time in their careers.



SPARQ SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM

Akin to the TREES Program, the **Supporting Placements Across Rural Queensland Scholarship** (SPARQ) is a TROHPIQ-funded scholarship which supports allied health students in completing placements in rural and remote areas. These **\$400** bursaries are given to **4 students** who demonstrate a enduring commitment and great interest in rural health. TROHPIQ members from **any allied health discipline** are encouraged to apply for the SPARQ Scholarship.

In 2025, TROHPIQ is determined yet again to expand our engagement with allied health students across all associated universities. Your support in the SPARQ Scholarship Program will be invaluable towards enabling more students to experience rural Queensland and promoting TROHPIQ's allied health activities.

SCHOLARSHIPS

TRANSPORT BURSARY

TROHPIQ is excited to offer a number of transport bursaries to support medical, nursing, allied health, dentistry and other health discipline (dietetics,

pharmacy etc.) students in getting to their placements in rural and remote areas. A total of **six bursaries valued up to \$300 each** will be made available throughout the year to students who demonstrate the greatest commitment and interest to rural health. NETWORKING // ADVOCACY

SCHOLARSHIPS & OPPORTUNITIES NIGHT

The Scholarships & Opportunities Night provides a chance for our partners and sponsors to connect directly with all TROHPIQ students across multiple disciplines and universities to showcase opportunities and supports available to them. This event offers the ideal time at the start of the year to engage students and encourage their interest in rural healthcare.

WOMEN IN RURAL MEDICINE & DIVERSE CAREERS NETWORKING NIGHT

The Women in Rural Medicine & Diverse Careers Networking Night is a collaboration between TROHPIQ and the UQ student club Supporting Women in Medicine (SWIM). This night offers an opportunity for students to meet and chat with women from diverse health careers and to learn how their work has intersected with rural health. In 2024, ten clinicians and more than 40 students were in attendance thanks to the generous support of our sponsors.



CAREERS IN RURAL HEALTH EVENING

In 2025, our Careers in Rural Health Evening remains a highlight of our networking events. This event introduces students from all sectors of healthcare to our wonderful panelists of senior nurses, allied health professionals and doctors working in rural Australia. We also hear from key stakeholders and organizations that propagate a sustainable rural health workforce. In 2024, we welcomed a crowd of over **40 students** across all disciplines.



TROHPIQ TRIVIA NIGHT

Every good club needs a **Trivia Night**! Students from **all disciplines** and universities, both non-member and member, come together to enjoy some jovial trivia. As some much-needed relaxation at the end of the year, this event gathers new TROHPIQ sign-ups and acts as a key moment in engaging next year's promising committee prospects. Our goals for 2025 are to expand this event with the help of generosity from our sponsors.

ACADEMIC EVENTS

MEDICAL SKILLS DAYS

TROHPIQ **Medical Skills Days** are designed to allow students to gain a practical understanding of clinical skills that can't be taught in a classroom. These events are highly popular, as nothing motivates workaholic medical students as much as an opportunity to further their knowledge.

With our unique TROHPIQ spin, we place a side focus on rural skills in a bush setting that will undoubtedly help to save lives in the future.

In 2024, we ran two of these events. Sessions included suturing, venipuncture, airway management, plastering, emergency patient scenarios and rural GP skills. Each session is run by a team of volunteer physicians, health professionals or skilled students. Many students find these workshops eye-opening and highly rewarding, relishing the opportunity to get hands-on.



MULTIDISCIPLINARY SKILLS DAY

A relatively new addition to TROHPIQ's calendar, our **Multidisciplinary Skills Day** has witnessed roaring success. Forging a connection between **medical**, **allied health and nursing students**, this event creates a collaborative

environment that builds teamwork and appreciation for all members of
healthcare. With workforce experts sharing their knowledge, student
feedback from this event has been incredibly positive!

In 2025, we plan to expand this event up from last year's **30+ students** and continue to foster interdisciplinary connections. We look for sponsors to assist with the purchasing of medical equipment/consumables for these workshops.

CULTURAL EVENTS

CULTURAL AWARENESS TRAINING

TROPHIQ believes that connection to Queensland's cultural diversity is pivotal to the future of healthcare. Our **Cultural Awareness Training** is an interactive, full-day workshop held in collaboration with **UQ TIME** (Towards International Medical Equity). It teaches students about the sociopolitical context of regional Queensland, Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander culture, and empowers delivery of culturally safe, informed and inclusive practice. This training day was mandatory for anyone applying for the **2024 Cherbourg Trip**. With your support, TROHPIQ hopes to increase the accessibility of this training opportunity to more students and strive towards a more culturally inclusive Australia.

REGIONAL EVENTS

TROHPIQ's longstanding partnership with UQ Rural Clinical School (RCS) is an integral aspect of our journey towards improving rural healthcare. With the recent inclusion of the Regional Medical Pathway, clinical sites in Toowoomba, Hervey Bay, Bundaberg and Rockhampton are bustling with more students than ever. TROHPIQ engages the over 150 students studying at these sites by hosting various social, academic and skills events throughout the year. These include our rural high school visits, annual social trips, orientation week BBQs, community events and end of year celebrations at each RCS.

RCS TRIP

RCS Trips are organised each year by TROHPIQ to offer preclinical medical students a taste of living and working in the regions. In 2025 we will be continuing to offer our **Hervey Bay trip.** The goal of this trip is to encourage Phase 1 students to complete their Phase 2 clinical placements (Years 3/4) at a Rural Clinical School. In 2024 and before, these trips were a highlight of the TROHPIQ and UQ RCS calendar and many of executive committee first joined TROHPIQ through these trips! This experience would absolutely not be possible without the support of our sponsors, and your generosity goes a long way to supporting equitable education opportunities for our students.





REGIONAL SPORTS EVENTS

In 2024, three Regional Sports Events were held. The Wide Bay RCS World Series provided a chance for the Bundaberg and Hervey Bay RCS students to battle it out on the sports field and get in some physical exercise. Students had a blast as they competed in basketball, beach volleyball and Kubb at Bargara. Not to be outdone, over **30 students** joined the Rockhampton Sports Day, with a BBQ in the park and multi-sport activities spanning across all year levels. We also had a sponsor come and give a talk to our keen students.

A new challenger this year, Toowoomba RCS joined in with a lawn bowls evening that was a big hit amongst 'T-Bar' locals! We hope to continue giving our students a feeling of belonging to their sites and enjoy their precious schooling years.

REGIONAL SOCIAL TRIPS / STUDENT CELEBRATIONS

Grand celebrations cap off another successful year at each clinical site. In 2024, these included a **Stanthorpe trip** for Toowoomba students, **Whale Watching at K'gari** for the Wide Bay students, and a **Great Keppel Island trip** for the Rockhampton students. These events encourage students to explore the beauty of their regional areas and always serves as a great memory for students. With growing numbers of students at the RCS sites in 2025, we would love to continue enriching our students' rural experiences!

These events always draw a massive crowd (**over 80%** of the RCS student group in 2024) and are a prime opportunity for our generous sponsors to show support in a direct way!
